## HOW CAN YOU VOTE IN MAINE?

### Mail In Your Ballot

Complete your absentee ballot at home and mail it in.

### In-Person on Election Day

Vote in-person on the day of the election.

### In-Person Early

Vote in-person, usually during a two to three week period before Election Day.

### Request a Ballot

Complete your absentee ballot at home and drop it at an official location.

If we are going to oppose authoritarianism, bigotry, & corruption, we can't use the tactics of the oppressor.

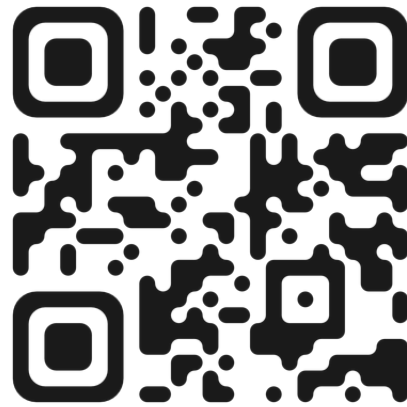
That means at least two things...
